## THROW-INS (6U to 8U)



# BUILD-OUT LINE (9U and 10U)

- The build-out line shall be placed across the penalty area and the halfway line. field equidistant between the top of the
- out of the back in a less pressured setting The build-out line promotes playing the ball
- If no line exists, use flat cones or some safe method to mark the location



### Build-Out Line (9U and 10U) Goal Keeper possession



- When the goalkeeper has the ball in his/her hands during play from the opponent, the opposing team released from the goalkeeper's possession must move behind the build-out line until the ball is
- who is on his/her side of the build-out line (punts and the goalkeeper can release the ball by passing (no Once the opposing team is behind the build-out line, drop kicks are not allowed) dribbling), throwing or rolling the ball to a teammate
- After the ball is released from the goalkeeper's line and play resumes as normal possession, the opposing team can cross the build-out

### Build-Out Line (9U and 10U) Goal Kicks



- The opposing team must move behind the buildout line during a goal kick until the ball is kicked
- The goalkeeper releasing the ball from possession or the player taking the goal kick does not have to build-out line wait for the opposing players to move behind the

### Build-Out Line (9U and 10U) **Guidance to Referees**



- Encourage the opponents to move quickly clock" until all opponents have retreated behind beyond the build-out line. Do not start the "6-sec
- The referee should position themselves on or very close to the build-out line and ask the players to stay behind until the ball is released.

### Build-Out Line (9U and 10U) Offside



- The build-out line shall be used as the line to determine offside. Players cannot be halfway line and the build-out line penalized for an offside offense between the
